



## **HYDROPONIC COMMUNITY GARDEN (OLD-FASHIONED "CO-OP")**



**With bad weather and rising gas prices driving up the cost of food, especially healthy organic food, we have decided to grow our own food year-round.**

**In return for your contribution of money, time, and/or labor, you will get a variety of fresh organic food, and have the opportunity to meet and work with like-minded friends and neighbors.**

### **Basic information:**

- **The garden will be located in a large barn building on Stardust Trail in Doney Park.**
- **We will be working with Sea of Green, a hydroponic gardening store that has just opened on East Route 66 in downtown Flagstaff.**
- **The initial effort will be to obtain the necessary equipment and supplies to start the garden, and to plant the crops.**
- **After the garden is set up and running, we only need to share the labor of caring for the garden and the ongoing costs of water and electricity. (And if we have members who can help us use solar power for running fans and heaters, we'll only have to pay for water!)**
- **This is not for profit – we will not be selling the food we grow. It is for the benefit and enjoyment of the members of the co-op.**
